Change proposed date February 15, 2020; vote on change will be held at our April 18, 2020 general meeting to meet the 30-day notification requirement:

### ARTICLE X - AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

Section 1 - These bylaws may be amended at any business meeting of the Guild by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided the amendment has been made available to the general membership thirty (30) days prior to the vote.

### 2020 Guild Quilt Block Theme

Due: July 18, 2020

Every year we put together a guild quilt with blocks made by our own guild members. These quilts become a permanent part of our quilt collection cared for and housed by Hibiscus Quilt Guild. RULES are:

- 1. Background fabric to be a tone on tone of your color choice
- 2. Your block may be made by using any quilting technique(s) of your choice. You can appliqué, embroidery, piece, or use a mixed technique.
- 3. If using embellishments, they must be securely attached.
- 4. The block must measure unfinished 9-1/2" square, but the design must fit within a 9" square area. Feel free to leave the block bigger and I will square it up for you.
- 5. You may do one to four block(s).
- 6. Pin you name to each block.
- 7. Your block or blocks must be turned in by July's General meeting.




